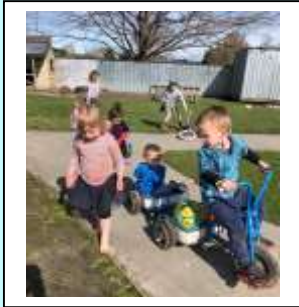
We have the Guy Fawkes Night coming up on the 8th of November. A great night out for families and it is also one of our fundraisers- starting at 6pm. There will be:
