This term at Kindergarten we are focusing on **fostering children's independence in becoming competent and confident learners**. We as teachers want to support children in becoming independent learners. Developing the skills to give it a go and understanding that failure is ok, as that is how we learn. Teachers want to empower children in developing a 'can do' attitude, where they give things a go for themselves first and then asking a friend or teacher for help if they are still stuck.

To further support children's learning we would like to ask parents to support children in taking responsibility for their own belongings; **such as encouraging children to put away bags and lunch boxes ready for the day ahead. As well as supporting them to get ready for the end of the day; such as putting their shoes on and packing their own bags.**

The younger children can also be supported in this by parents talking through the steps to prepare their child for the day ahead or getting their child ready at the end of the day.
